The London trip is fast approaching. The big day is Wednesday 12th June and no train strikes have been announced! Your child will need to be in York train station near the cash and ticket machines at **7.15am**. Staff will be there to greet children. Your child needs to register with their class teacher.

Preparing for the day

- Your child will need 2 pack ups for lunch and tea and snacks for the day.
- They will also need enough drinks for the day. It might be easier to send some drinks in disposable bottles so that during the day your child's bag will get lighter. I am sure the theatre would fill up water bottles if needed, but please do not rely on us being able to purchase or refill bottles during the day.
- The children will need to be in suitable clothing (non uniform) and very comfortable shoes / trainers for walking around and the vast majority of the day is outside so sun cream, caps, waterproofs will be required.
- Children can bring a camera, which they will be responsible for. Their camera cannot be
 a phone. Any phones which are brought on the trip, will be confiscated and given back
 to the child once we have returned to York. Staff cannot take responsibility for the loss
 of any cameras or phones which are brought in by the children. Staff will take plenty of
 photos and these will be tweeted. We will also be uploading all photos to a Google drive
 folder which will then be shared with all children.
- Children may bring up to £10 to buy themselves a souvenir from a gift shop or from the theatre.

Here is our itinerary for the day.

- Arrive at London Kings Cross.
- Tube to Bank where we will make a stop at a souvenir shop and then head to Horizon 22.
- We will arrive at Horizon 22 at 11am. Horizon 22 is London's highest viewing platform with 300 degrees views of London's most iconic landmarks. Children are welcome to bring binoculars.
- We will then get the tube to Westminster and walk down to St James Park taking in the sights.
- We will then have lunch in St James Park.
- After lunch, we will continue on our walk up the Mall to see Buckingham Palace and head to the theatre.
