**Sing Education**

We chose Sing Education to help deliver music because it enables a specialist music teacher to teach the children music across school and it also provides invaluable CPD for our teachers. Sing Education provide a bespoke curriculum, designed to provide children with active music-making and progressive musical learning. Music lessons follow a sequenced and progressive curriculum, fully in line with the Model Music Curriculum and Development Matters, building pupils' skill and knowledge incrementally to prepare them for KS3 and the wider world of music.

**Tailoring Music at Carr**

At Carr Junior School, a specialist music teacher from Sing Education is employed to teach music across school. In order to supplement the Sing Education curriculum, we also ensure that pupils learn about a number of significant pieces of music during their time at Carr Junior School. Pupils are immersed in some of these pieces of music as they enter and leave assembly and study the life and work of a great composer as part of our Big Idea in Autumn 2.

Here are the great composer and musicians studies in each year group:

Year 3 - Antonio Vivaldi and The Four Seasons

Year 4 - Camille Saint-Saens and The Carnival of the Animals

Year 5 - Gustav Holst and The Planets

Year 6 - Tchaikovsky and The Nutcracker

Programming Music is also taught through our Computing scheme of work.

**Carr Junior School Assembly Music Timetable**

Developing children's knowledge of significant pieces of music is an important part of their education at Carr Junior School. As a result, we have a 3-year cycle of assembly music which pupils listen to as they enter and leave the hall for assembly. A different piece of music is played each half term. Where possible a video of an orchestra playing these pieces is shown on the hall screen to support pupils' understanding of the music and the parts played by sections of the orchestra. Teachers leading the assembly will discuss the music and refer to a poster in the hall about the piece and its composer. The table below sets out the sequence of music pupils will learn about.
