How do I know if I will be eligible to apply for free school meals?

- · You can apply for free school meals if you are in receipt of any of the following:
- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net income of no more than £7,400).
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an
 annual household gross income that does not exceed £16,190).
- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance. Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999. The guarantee element of Pension Credit. A run-on of Working Tax Credit - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

What is it?

The Carr Offer is a package of support available from school for those low income families eligible for free school meals.

What are the benefits for me?

- Pupils will be provided with:
- A school jumper or cardigan.
- One white polo t-shirt.
- Free extra-curricular club participation, book on Parentpay as usual with no cost.
- Free school trips (excluding residentials) and participation in Big Idea launch days, book on Parentpay as usual with no cost.
- Water bottle.

- Free school lunches.
- Target Pupil Premium pupils will receive an age appropriate current book, at different points in the year

What are the benefits for school?

School receives additional funding based on the number of pupils registered as FSM. This contributes to staff training, additional staffing and various support packages and is nationally known as Pupil Premium Funding.

What if my child doesn't want others to know?

Other pupils will not know which families are being supported or which children are eligible. Staff will of course be sensitive and provide anonymity for pupils.

What do I need to do?
