World Book Day 2025 is fast approaching and takes place on **Thursday 6th March**. The theme is **Read Your Way**, celebrating the reading that children choose to do in their free time without judgement. **Read Your Way** encourages everyone to let go of reading pressures and expectations, and lets children find fun in reading. This is something we are very passionate about at Carr Junior School.

Nurseries, schools and libraries across the UK will be celebrating World Book Day with a huge range of events and activities. We would love to celebrate World Book Day in style but without putting pressure on parents to provide costumes. We would like the children to come to school in their comfiest reading clothes or pyjamas and to bring with them **three items** that would give clues to a children's book character. For example, children may bring a red ribbon, a book and jar of honey to represent Roald Dahl's Matilda. Throughout the day, the children will be playing 'Guess Who?' in their classes to work out what character each child has represented through their three items.

Book Fair

This year we have arranged a Book Fair! Unfortunately, due to high demand, this could not take place on World Book Day itself but will happen on **Wednesday 12th March**. Each class will spend 20/30 mins with Derek from Primary Books where he will read riddles and stories as well as give children an opportunity to browse and/or buy books. If children would like to buy a book, please remember to send them to school with some money to make a purchase. They will soon come home with an envelope to put their money in. Children can also reserve books with Derek for parents/carers to purchase at the end of the day where the book fair will be open for approximately 30 mins to an hour for parents/carers to browse and purchase books with the children. Children can also use their World Book Day tokens to either take £1 off the cost of any book over the value of £2.99 or to purchase one of the World Book Day books (subject to availability). They will be given their World Book Day tokens prior to the fair.

World Book Day celebrates the joy and value of books and reading, especially for children. To help motivate them with their reading journey, children receive a £1 World Book Day Book Token. With books for beginning, early, fluent and independent readers, there is something for everyone!

Your child's token will be given to them in class and can be redeemed at most UK bookshops. Please help your child to use it on or around World Book Day by visiting your local bookshop.

Here at Carr Junior School we recognise the value of reading and want to encourage our Carr Stars to read for pleasure. You can join us in building your child's enthusiasm for books and reading well beyond World Book Day by reading together regularly and talking about books, authors and illustrators that you enjoy.
